

## RBI Data Notes

The CEDA data portal includes RBI data on [Capital Expenditure, Revenue Expenditure and Revenue Receipts of states and union territories with legislatures](#). The data which spans from 1991 to 2021 covers the actual expenditures at the state level under each of the three categories mentioned before. Since the series shows the actual expenditures, it could take a period of upto two years before the values of a certain year are released on the RBI site. The variables under each of the three categories are summarised in the table below.

For each of the above variables, the portal has -

1. Current values in millions of rupees.
2. Constant values in millions of rupees (base year as 2011)
3. Per capita current values
4. Per capita constant values
5. Share of the respective total categories (for example, share of an item in the capital expenditure column as a percentage of total capital disbursements, or similarly share of an item in the revenue expenditure column as a percentage of total revenue expenditures.
6. Percentage of the State GDP.
